<b>Presentation(s)</b>	<p>Jennifer Priddy - Assistant Superintendent - <i>February 2020 Replacement Levy</i></p> <p>This levy is still critical to the operation of our school district. The "McCleary Fix" law didn't help our funding model - in fact, it made it worse for the OSD.</p> <p>The way the state funds schools is they allocate a certain number of staff per students. For example, we are only funded 1.5 nurses for all 10,000 students. We fund the rest of our nurses with our levy.</p> <p>This is our Educational Programs and Operations Levy - it replaces the levy enacted in 2016. The maximum is \$2.50, and we will likely collect less. The state limits the amount we can collect. This levy is lower than what has historically been enacted. It's lower than what was enacted in 2016.</p> <p><i>Is this a replacement levy?</i></p> <p>Yes. We are already paying for it.</p> <p>Right now we are paying \$5.15. This will slowly decline to \$4.84 over the four years. 2020 - \$5.15, 2021, \$5.05- it will decline slowly.</p> <p><i>What does the levy pay for?</i></p> <p>The levy pays for all athletics, special education services for students who qualify, additional staff over and above that the state funds (nurses, for example - but all across our system - counselors, paras, custodians), extra transportation (Brain Train).</p> <p>We have an FAQ on the website and a website called Levy2020 Election is February 11, 2020.</p>
