Meeting Commenced with technical difficulties about how to set up Zoom.

We are tightening up safety in response to the recent shooting in Uvalde, TX. We are reevaluating our points of entry. The district will be building a vestibule. We have started locking the exterior doors between the gym and the cafeteria. Students will use key cards to be able to get in and out. The doors will be open automatically during passing time. The front door will be locked during school hours. Visitors will have to ring a doorbell and get buzzed in.

More speeches. A reading of the names. Then they had a 15 minute moment of silence. They walked around the building several times. They gathered again on the field.
