Inspiration Campaign - bathroom doors are being sponsored for \$40 each to put an inspirational glossy vinyl on bathroom doors; As we get donations, we'll put them up; people can choose the quotes and pictures they want on the doors.

Fundraising

Movie Event: CSI has been successful with movie events - showing an old movie on the big screen - they usually bring in around \$5K; Jeni asked the CSI teachers if they mind that we also show a movie, *Wizard of Oz*, on October 14. They said yes, and we got Capitol Theater reserved for October 14th. We will publicize and can have a raffle, a bake sale... they have volunteers to work concessions.... It costs \$1121 to reserve the space.

How will we sell tickets? What is our plan? We will have posters printed by this Friday. We want parents to spread the word. OFS has online ticket ordering. The QR code will be on the posters. Tickets will be sold at the student store. If bought online, there's a \$3.00 surcharge. Tickets are \$10.00 in the student store. We need help with putting up posters. Buy and sell tickets. Get raffle prizes. The theater will give us 300 to 500 tickets. This is open to the entire Olympia community.

How can we advertise to kids? We can put into morning announcements, put posters around the school, sell at Curriculum Night and games and after school.
