Principal's Report	Great start! We are over enrollment right now by 15 - which mostly means that we can't take anyone from our waitlist. We have 421 students as of today. We have had zero kids out of class for discipline. Period. We do have a Restoration Room for students who need to take a break, and a couple of students have used it for emotional reasons. We had a guest speaker, Stu Cabe, yesterday who delivered the message to "Be Big" not little in relation to doing the right thing. Students seemed to love it. Stu met with leadership kids afterwards to discuss how to educate students regarding negative language. We have a leadership class this year which helped sponsor Stu Cabe. Core-Flex in September: we spend the month teaching PBIS

	<p>expectations; for example, today we taught them how to behave outside; We also practice all of our emergency drills;</p> <p>Fundraiser kick-off toward the end of the month - Mustang Dash Scavenger Hunt on October 4; families donate \$20 each and all kids get to participate in a school wide scavenger hunt; students who donate \$20 go into a drawing for prizes and are eligible for a movie and popcorn day.</p> <p>Every Monday students will check their grades through Skyward. They will make a plan for the week for where to go for Core-Flex. If they have grades of C- or lower, they must get help; if they are doing well, they can go have an extra break.</p> <p>Question about lockdown drill - how much preparation and debrief? We have moved to the ALICE system as a district. We use our first drill to teach students how to do it. We need to debrief after every drill all year long. We also need to communicate the probability of any emergency event. Add to the message a way for students to talk to an adult after the fact if necessary. What are resources for parents?</p> <p>We have a ton of kids who have come out for sports. We have 60 girls for volleyball and 26-28 boys for soccer. We need more coaches! We hope to have a schedule for sports by Friday.</p>
